2010 Fraiser Scholarship Winner

We are pleased to announce that **Andrew Birling** is the winner of our Frasier Organ Scholarship for 2010. Our chapter will present him with the \$1000 award at our Annual Membership Meeting/Officer Installation/Potluck Dinner to be held 4:30 pm on Sunday, June 6, at Bethel Lutheran Church in Cupertino. Congratulations, Andrew!

Andrew has been serving as Director of Music at Campbell United Methodist Church since 2005. Prior to that, from 1992 until 2005, he served as Organist or Organist/Director of Music at five different churches. For his Frasier audition, Andrew performed Buxtehude's "Toccata in F Major," Brahms' chorale prelude on "Herzlich Tut Mich Verlangen," Rorem's "In Nomine Domine," and the hymn "Lobe den Herren." Andrew plans to use the Frasier scholarship award for private organ study with **Sandra Soderlund** at Mills College.

The Frasier auditions were held at Immanuel Lutheran Church, San Jose, on Saturday afternoon, May 1. The judges were very encouraging of all three applicants this year, and reported that they struggled to make a decision, which ended up being very close. They selected Andrew as the 2010 Frasier winner, and encouraged the other applicants to apply again for the scholarship.

Our San Jose AGO chapter extends sincere appreciation to **Dick Coulter**, **Carolyn Pryor**, and **Joyce Rhodes**, who served as the three judges for this year's Frasier scholarship auditions. We also thank Immanuel Lutheran Church, San Jose, and host organist **Darryl Parker** for graciously allowing the Frasier applicants to practice and prepare their audition pieces there, and for hosting the Frasier auditions again this year. – Valerie Sterk
