Please join us on **Sunday, August 21**, from **2-5 p.m.** for an Open House at our Benicia plant. Assembled on our erecting room floor is a **three manual, 28 rank organ** to be installed at **First Presbyterian Church of Monterey**. This organ is very special – a **re-creation of a 1912 Murray M. Harris** organ employing many original pipes. Refreshments and a plant tour are included.

Directions: From I-80: At Vallejo, take I-780 east towards Benicia. After East Fifth St exit, get into right lane and exit onto I-680 North (Exit 7A). From

I-680: At Benicia, take the Lake Herman Road exit (Exit 61). Go east (toward the water) on Lake Herman Road and cross the railroad overpass. Take the first right onto Industrial Way and go 1.3 miles. The plant is on the right just past a curve – look for the 42' tall erecting room!
