

Recently Passed Away

Frieda Ann Murphy, January 12, 1930 – June 30, 2017, Resident of Campbell



Frieda Ann Murphy passed away on Friday, June 30, 2017 at Palm Villas in Campbell, California. In her later years she developed Alzheimer's disease and was fortunate to be in a facility where the staff took excellent care of her. Frieda was a native Californian and lived a life blessed with music and her love of teaching piano to hundreds of children. She was an accomplished concert organist, having studied in Belguim with Flor Peeters for three years. She will be remembered as an outstanding musician, a caring

NEW ADDITIONS UNDER CONSTRUCTION FOR HISTORIC MURRAY HARRIS ORGAN

Construction of the new period-style **Great 8' Trumpet** and **4' Clarion** for the Murray Harris organ at **Memorial Church at Stanford** is well underway in the shops of **Hupalo & Repasky**!

Additions to such truly historic organs require special attention to period work methods, styles and details, above and beyond normal considerations. In the process we study the existing pipes, windchests, drawings, recordings, and all other available Murray Harris organs and other period organs to emulate in our designs for this project.

The evolving musical needs of the church exert strong influence over tonal designs by the organbuilders. Modern organ literature often calls for a type of Trumpet sound that was not so prevalent in America at the time this organ was built. So in order to keep this fine historic organ relevant for today's musical needs, while keeping in character with the original tonal design, the new Trumpet 8' and Clarion 4' follow the design philosophy of the great 19th-century English organbuilder, William Hill & Sons.

This organ will also be enhanced with the addition of a new **Solo Tuba Mirabilis 8'**, constructed and voiced in the style of the great English Victorian-era builder, Father Henry Willis. He was a contemporary of Murray Harris and was a renowned reed pipe voicer in his own rite.

For this project we have made a number of trial pipes, to determine the most optimum scaling, reed tongue thicknesses, shapes, and curvatures, as well as finalizing the optimum shallot shape and dimensions to meet the musical needs of this addition. Upon completion in the shop and voicing room, the trial pipes are brought to the church and heard with the ensemble in the church's own acoustic environment. In this way can we be certain before the final pipes are made, that we have accomplished everything needed to meet expectations for such an important addition to this organ.

The intricate Harris electro-pneumatic windchests have inspired many variations on his basic principles of design and he set many construction standards for the entire industry. Our windchest conforms to all of the Harris standards for toe sizes, pouch and valve sizes, note channeling and primary valves, etc. for fast, reliable, and long-enduring chest action.
