UGO SFORZA IN RECITAL: 15 SEPTEMBER 2017



Ugo Sforza, an accomplished Italian organist and composer, will present an organ recital on Friday evening, September 15, at 7:30pm at Sunnyvale Presbyterian Church (728 W. Fremont Ave. Sunnyvale 94087). There is no admission charge; donations to Ugo will be received at the door. Mr. Sforza presented a wonderful recital for us each of the past three years, and we are eager to welcome him back to the Bay Area for another inspiring performance. Invite your friends and family to join us for this evening of organ music, and for the reception following.

Ugo's program will include a variety of exciting organ repertoire. He will open his recital with J.S. Bach's organ transcription, BWV 593, of

Vivaldi's RV 522 concerto for strings (from *Estro Armonico*). As in past recitals, Ugo will honor us with a first performance of his newest composition, *Petite Fantaisie*, op. 21, for organ duet; followed by a set of variations composed by Valerie Sterk. He will close his program with Louis Vierne's grand Symphony no. 6 in B Minor, op. 59. Toshiko was a member of our chapter for many years until this last year.

I received the following from her son Eddie.

"This is Toshiko's son, Eddie. Thank you very much for acknowledging my Mom. The organ was very much a part of our family. She met my Dad Jerry while he was in the Air Force stationed in Japan. Her English teacher in college suggested she attend an American church in order for her to practice her English. Well, upon attending the Tokyo Lutheran Church she developed a love for the organ and also met and married my Dad. She was very active playing the organ and singing in the choir everywhere my Dad was stationed. After Dad's retirement, they settled down in the Bay Area and Mom was the organist at Mt. Olive for almost four decades."

SCHOENSTEIN OPEN HOUSE HELD 20 Aug 2017

Schoenstein & Co. celebrated its 140th anniversary with an Open House demonstrating new organs for Holy Cross Church, San Jose, CA and Mikell Chapel of the Cathedral of St. Philip, Atlanta, GA. The 150 guests were fascinated with the extremely complex arrangement of pipes, windchests, bellows and wind conductors necessary to fit in the Chapel's small, irregular shaped chamber, "One of our most challenging installation sites!" said company president Jack Bethards.

Twenty-four members of the founding Schoenstein family representing the fourth, fifth and sixth generations joined the celebration and presented a commerative glass sculpture for the firm's archive, which includes Schoenstein records and artifacts dating from the mid-19th century in Germany.
