
# Dean's Message


#### **Student Recital**

## 1889 II/12 Woodberry & Harris Organ To Be Installed at Star of the Sea Catholic Church San Francisco, California

We are thrilled to announce the placement of this beautiful, historic pipe organ into the rear balcony at Star of the Sea Catholic Church in San Francisco, CA.



Consistent with the vision of Fr. Joseph Illo to restore the beautiful rose window, seen in this south wall image, to its original prominence in this magnificent sanctuary. the organ's facade has been reconfigured to frame and highlight the rose window, returning both the window and

the familiar original pipe facade back into the fundamental visual aspect of the rear balcony.

The goals of the church were two-fold; to re-expose the beautiful rose window behind the organ, (which is currently plastered over), and the organist and music director, Lynn Kraehling's wish for a fine tracker organ to complement his rapidly expanding music program.

After attending our Sept 24 Open House celebration, Mr. Kraehling felt that this organ was one of the most beautiful-sounding organs of its period, and with its warm, rich, choir-friendly tonal design, it would fit perfectly into his music program for the church. He is also excited to have this historic instrument to introduce the burgeoning Millennial presence in his choir and congregation to the grand legacy of American organbuilding at its finest.

Originally built in 1889 for the First Universalist Church in Melrose, MA, this organ faithfully served for 89 years until 1978, when the church merged with another congregation and moved away.

The organ then traveled west and was fully restored by organbuilder Manuel Rosales for Avalon Community Church on Santa Catalina Island. It remained there until 1995, when it was moved to San Francisco, ultimately coming to rest at the Pacific Lutheran Theological Seminary in Berkeley CA.

Its new permanent home at the historic Star of the Sea Catholic Church in San Francisco could hardly be a more appropriate and beautiful setting for the long term future of this lovely instrument.
