These weekly concerts were started in June 2020. The First Anniversary Concert was streamed on 30 June 2021 and it featured selections from all five organists plus the third movement from the Brandenburg Concerto No. 3 played by all five organists on one organ. The total program lasts 43 minutes.

A short tour of the Assembly Hall Practice Rooms, a portion of the Tabernacle Organ Chamber, and a Discussion of Organ Pedals and Pedaling by Richard Elliot were also included.

The featured organs are the Tabernacle Organ (Aeolian-Skinner, refurbished by Schoenstien), the Assembly Hall Organ (Robert L. Sipe Organ), and the Joseph Smith Chapel Organ (Casavant Frères Organ).


Gulbransen Organ Seeking New Home

Organ Humor



Dobson Pipe Organ Builders Facility Destroyed in Fire.

The Dobson Pipe Organ Builders facility in Lake City, Iowa, was destroyed by a fire on June 15, 2021. A malfunction in the dust collection system had seemingly ignited sawdust at the premises of Dobson Pipe Organ Builders, the internationally renowned company that John Panning owns in Lake City, Iowa.

Within hours, the resulting blaze had flattened the corner lot the building occupied, incinerating fixtures and fittings but thankfully sparing the employees working there that day.

Dobson Pipe Organ Builders has established itself as one of the foremost makers of pipe organs, with nearly 100 instruments in churches, schools, concert halls and homes throughout the United States, plus one in England at Merton College in Oxford, England.

Lynn Dobson 'got his start' with a project at Olivet Congregational Church in St. Paul. Although technically his Opus 4, that organ was Lynn's first significant instrument, and he brokered its success into a firm deserving of world acclaim, and a reputation bolstered by recent installations at St. Thomas Church on Fifth Avenue in New York City and the University of Dubuque.

A large organ for a church in Australia (Opus 99) was under construction at the shop at the time of this devastating fire. "We're probably a month or two away from really beginning to get started on the Sydney organ again," he says. Not only present projects, but also the company's historic documents, and the personal, specialized tools of its craftspeople were all consumed by Tuesday's conflagration.
