St. Mary's Cathedral to Celebrate the 50th Anniversary of the Cathedral Choirs

On **Sunday, April 3, 2022**, the Cathedral of St. Mary of the Assumption in San Francisco will mark the 50th anniversary of the Cathedral Choirs with a festive concert at **4 pm**. Participating will the **St. Mary's Cathedral Choir**, the **St. Brigid School Honor Choir**, and the **Cathedral String Ensemble**, under the direction of **Christoph Tietze** and **Ash Walker**, and assisted by Marni Strome and **Jin Kyung Lim**.

The program will begin with the Third Brandenburg Concerto by Bach, followed by choral works with a Marian theme, including the "Stabat mater" by Josef Rheinberger.

The highlight of the program will be a specially commissioned work by Hungarian composer **Barna Szabo**, the Cantata "Ave mundi spes, Maria," with the text based on a 15th century sequence. Mr. Szabo teaches at the Liszt Academy in Budapest and is one of the rising stars among European composers.

A donation of \$20 per person, \$10 for seniors and students, will be requested at the door.

AGO's Volunteer Organists Category

In January 2017 at the suggestion of the AGO's Councillor for Education Don Cook and with the backing of the Committee on Membership Development and Chapter Support and the AGO National Council, AGO introduced a pilot program establishing a new category of membership for "Volunteer Organists. During the pilot period, this offer was extended to those who attended an educational workshop for volunteer organists hosted by Don Cook.

Regretfully after 5 years, this pilot program has been discontinued. Today (25 Feb 2022), we changed all Volunteer Members with active memberships to Young Organist, Regular, or Special based on their date of birth. If there was no date of birth listed on their membership record, they were changed to Regular. Future invoices will reflect this change, and each person whose membership was affected was sent a letter explaining the change.

For now, canceled Volunteer Members will continue to be listed as Volunteer Members on your member roster. If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to reach out.
