The American Guild of Organists invites you to OrganFest 2021, June 27–July 2. This year, in the absence of AGO Regional Conventions, we wanted to provide a week in which we could again enjoy outstanding performers and instruments, be entertained by a wide variety of musical styles, learn new skills, and mingle with old and new friends at after-parties.

The backbone of OrganFest is a collection of performances from all seven AGO regions, presented on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday evenings. These programs will also include minidocumentaries highlighting some of our colleagues, as well as an improvised silent movie accompaniment, a featured young organist, and the winner of the National Competition in Organ Improvisation.

An exciting new offering this year is interactive content on Tuesday and Thursday evenings via Zoom, which is free for all AGO members. (Nonmembers may access this programming for a \$50 fee, which includes a complimentary six-month Guild membership as well as online access to The American Organist magazine.) These two days will include the final round of the National Competition in Organ Improvisation—with the opportunity to vote for an Audience Prize—and the premieres of two Pogorzelski-Yankee award-winning compositions, along with conversations with the performers and composers. We will also

enjoy panel discussions on organ building and diversifying repertoire, as well as presentations on improvisation and building a career as a collaborative musician.

Schoenstein to Waco

A new three-manual, 27-voice, 32-rank organ under construction at the Schoenstein & Co. factory is to be installed at St. Alban's Episcopal Church in Waco, Texas as part of a major campus-wide expansion and renovation of this rapidly growing parish. The main organ is in a north chancel chamber. Unenclosed stops for congregational support and children's choir accompaniment along with the Pedal Open Wood are in the west gallery. Acoustical consultation is by Paul Scarbrough of Akustiks LLC, Norwalk, CT. The tonal design is focused on support of the Anglican service. The organist and director of music is Eugene Lavery.
