# Frasier Organ Scholarship 2017 Winner, Eleanor Muhawi

Congratulations to **Eleanor Muhawi**, the winner of the 2017 Frasier Organ Scholarship! The Frasier auditions were held on Saturday afternoon, May 6, at Sunnyvale Presbyterian Church. Our San Jose AGO chapter will present Eleanor with the \$1,000 award and acknowledge her at an AGO event next fall. She has been invited to present an organ recital for our chapter sometime next year.

For her Frasier audition, Eleanor performed the well-known *Toccata and Fugue in D Minor* by J.S. Bach, *Prière* by Jean Langlais, "Allegro maestoso e Vivace" from *Sonata no.* 2 by Felix Mendelssohn, and the hymn "Praise to the Lord, the Almighty"

(Lobe den Herren).

Eleanor is a freshman at Notre Dame High School in San Jose. She has studied piano for seven years, and has been taking organ lessons with **Dr. James Welch** for the past two years. Eleanor has experience playing organ for her school masses at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Joseph, and for masses at her church, St. Leo the Great Catholic Parish in San Jose. She plans to use the Frasier scholarship to continue her weekly organ lessons. When asked about her goals in studying music, Eleanor replied that she plans to serve her community through music, to continue serving as a church organist, and may possibly decide to study music further in college.

**Abilities:** The applicant must have experience playing the organ and piano in church services and accompanying choirs and instrumentalists. Sight reading skills and a background in musical liturgy are required.

PCLG has an average attendance of 300 per Sunday. The organ is a three manual Möller from 1958, expanded twice by Schoenstein & Co. and totaling 39 ranks. It has been fastidiously maintained by Schoenstein & Co. The sanctuary has a Baldwin grand piano, which has had recent voicing and action work, and a Kohler & Campbell grand in the choir room.

The adult Chancel Choir has approximately 30 voices and sings at most Sunday services from early September to the second week in June, as well as for several services in the summer. The congregation is enthusiastic about all kinds of music, with a special appreciation for the pipe organ.

The church currently needs a third organist, who would join a rotating roster with two other organists. Each organist plays one or two times a month throughout the year, depending on the number of Sundays in a month. When the choir is in session, the organist playing a Sunday service usually rehearses with the choir the previous Thursday. The organist uses a piano during the choir rehearsal, which is held in the choir room and led by the music director. The rotating organists decide their

schedule, based on their availability and in collaboration with the music director.

Holy Redeemer Lutheran Church, 1948 The Alameda, San Jose, CA, is looking for a Part-Time Musician. We are looking for about 300 hours per year (~ 6 hours per week). These hours include: Sunday morning for worship, five special services during the year, staff meeting each month, about 16 choir practices during the year (the choir only sings on Festival Sundays and a few other Sundays during the year). We have budgeted \$6500/year for this position. Additionally there are 2 weeks of vacation (paid substitute) and the normal benefits (FICA, etc.). We do not offer health care.
